BEMtoken

BEM -A TRC20 token in the Tron Blockchain with 50,000,000 (Fifty Million) maximum supply.

TRON

Tron launched in 2017 is a blockchain similar to Ethereum. But it is much faster and the transaction fee is very lesser compared to the Ethereum.

In 2018, TRON switched its protocol from an ERC-20 token on top of Ethereum to an independent peer-to-peer network. After that, marketed to rival Ethereum, TRON boomed in market capitalization during the early part of 2018, becoming a top 10 cryptocurrency. The market cap of Tron is \$1,145,333,571 as on 1 Sep, 2020.

Like Ethereum, one can deploy smart contracts on the Tron Blockchain and use it for any purpose.

TRC20 TOKEN

TRC20 (TRC20 Token Standard) is a token standard based on the implementation of smart contract when using TRON network to issue a token. In order to swap, transfer, share token and be supported by digital wallets, all the TRC20 tokens follow a series of specifications which include 3 optional items and 6 required items.

3 Optional Items: 1) Token Name string
public constant name = "BEM"; 2) Token
Abbreviation

For example, BEMT is the abbreviation of BEM. BEM and BEMT represent the same token, but BEMT is more simple.
string public constant symbol = "BEMT";

3) Token Precision

Token precision is the minimum divisible unit. Precision 0 means the minimum divisible unit is 1. Precision 2 means the minimum divisible unit is 0.01. The maximum value of precision is 18.

1) totalSupply()

This function returns the total supply of the token.

2) balanceOf()

This function returns the token balance of the specific account.

3) transfer()

This function is used to transfer an amount of tokens from the smart contract to a specific address.

4) approve()

This function is used to authorize the third party (like a DAPP smart contract) to transfer token from the token owner's account.

5) transferFrom()

This function is used to allow the third party to transfer token from an owner account to a receiver account. The owner account must be approved to be called by the third party.

Compared to transfer(), what's the meaning of transferFrom()?

By using transferFrom(), the third party can transfer token from your account to another account automatically.

6) allowance()

This function is used to query the remaining amount of tokens the third party can transfer.

Approve() can authorize the third party to transfer token from the owner account, then through transferFrom() it can transfer token to a receiver account.

For example:

Alice owns 1000 TRX, if he wants to allow the third party contract C to manipulate 100 TRX from his account:

Call approve(C, 100) using Alice's account

Contract C wants to transfer 10 TRX to Bob from Alice. Call transferFrom(Alice, Bob, 10) using contract C's account.

Call allowance(Alice, C) to query the remaining tokens that the contract C can transfer from Alice's account.

When approval() is successfully called, it has to trigger Approval Event.

WHAT IS BEM?

BEM is a TRC20 token created on the Tron Blockchain. The maximum supply of the token is restricted to 50,000,000 BEM. Unlike other tokens, people can buy the tokens directly from the smart contract and stake them to receive dividends. The pre-sale goes live on Nov 4, 2020 at 12:00 HRS UTC and ends on Nov 24, 2020 at 12:00 HRS. During the pre-sale, the cost of 1 BEM token is 2 TRX and after the pre-sale, the cost of 1 BEM token is 10 TRX. Once the total supply has reached the maximum supply 50,000,000 BEM, the minting will stop and only the maximum

supply 50,000,000 BEM will be a circulating supply. If the total supply does not reach the maximum supply within Dec 24, 2020, the difference between total and maximum supply will be minted and destroyed or burned.

WHAT IS THE USE CASE OF BEM?

BEM is a DEFI token which can be staked to earn dividends. Right from the time you buy the BEM token, you start to earn dividends until you get back 200 percent of your TRX investment. The dividend percentage depends upon the number of BEM tokens you hold.

Dividends:

If you hold < 1000 BEM, you will earn 0.10% daily dividends until you earn 50% of your TRX investment.

If you hold > 1000 BEM and < 5000 BEM tokens, you will earn 0.30% daily dividends until you earn 50% of your TRX investment.

If you hold > 5000 BEM, you will earn 0.60% daily dividends until you earn 50% of your TRX investment.

Not just staking, BEM will be used as the main currency to transact in all the BEM Future projects. 50 Percent of the net revenue from all the BEM Tron project will be distributed as divs to all the BEM holders.

TRADE BEM / DIVIDENDS

Where to Buy BEM?

BEM is a smart contract. You can buy BEM by directly interacting with the smart contract. As an alternate, you can buy BEM from the DAPP UI (<https://www.bemdefi.io>).

Where to Sell BEM?

After Dec 24, 2020, you can sell BEM on the DEFI exchange JustSwap (<https://www.justswap.io/>).

Where to trade BEM?

You can trade BEM on JustSwap (<https://www.justswap.io/>) after Dec 24, 2020 and on PoloniDex after Jan 24, 2020.

How does the BEM Tron pay the dividends?

JustSwap charges an exchange fee for every BEM trade that happen on their DEFI exchange and pay commission to the BEM TRON. The dividends are paid from the commission.

HOW TO MAKE MONEY OUT OF BEM TRON?

- 1) Buy BEM for a cheap price during the pre-sale and collect dividends.
- 2) Stake BEM and earn Staking Rewards when the staking is enabled.
- 3) Sell BEM at JustSwap for a higher price.
- 4) Buy a minimum 5 BEM token and refer people to earn referral commission.
- 5) Hold BEM and earn dividends from the BEM Tron's future projects.

FUTURE PROJECTS / REVENUE SHARING / TEAM

Future Projects

- 1) Video sharing portal with an inbuilt ad – network: The model is similar to YouTube but without restrictions and limitations.
- 2) Casino: Addictive and Attractive provably fair casino games with low house edge.

Revenue Sharing:

50% of the net revenue of all the BEM Tron's projects will be distributed as dividends to all the BEM holders.

You earn dividends in TRX (up to 50%) for holding the BEM token and also get a share of the revenue from BEM TRON's future projects forever. BEM being a defi token, you can also stake BEM and earn staking rewards after staking is enabled.
